## Triathlon

THE Mandurah Triathlon Club is encouraging everyone in the community to enter The Athlete's Foot Corporate Triathlon in Mandurah on February 21.

The event is open to business, sporting and community groups.

The Mandurah Triathlon Club was established in 1988 and from humble beginnings now has more than 150 members.

In addition to hosting a regular number of local triathlons the club has successfully hosted the WA State Interclub, a landmark event on the State Triathlon Calendar.

The club is looking to expand on this success with the inaugural corporate event which will be a team event (three participants per team).

Teams have the option of completing the 500m swim, 15km cycle and 4km as a team or as individuals.

The City of Mandurah and the Department of Sport and Recreation are supporting the event.

Local sponsors Snap Printing Mandurah, Webset and naming rights sponsor The Athlete's Foot Mandurah have been instrumental in the planning and financial backing of the first competition.

Athlete's Foot Mandurah owner Roger Ricupero said it was a great concept and he was pleased to be involved.

The City of Mandurah will be running a Training Program leading up to the event to help participants with training preparation, nutritional information.
